1Co 10:16 The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not a **communion** of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not a **communion** of the body of Christ? *ASV*

Luk 22:18-20 For I tell you that from now on I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." (19)

And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "**This is my body**, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." (20) And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is **the new covenant in my blood**."

According to the [American Heritage Dictionary](#), the definition of leaven is: “1. An agent, such as yeast, that causes batter or dough to rise, especially by fermentation. 2. An element, influence, or agent that works subtly to lighten, enliven, or modify a whole.”

Exo 12:39 And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough that they had brought out of Egypt, for it was not leavened, because they were thrust out of Egypt and could not wait, nor had they prepared any provisions for themselves.

Discussion: Yeast

"What lessons does God want us to learn from the Old Testament concept of yeast?"



Lev 2:11 "No grain offering that you bring to the LORD shall be made with leaven, for you shall burn no leaven nor any honey as a food offering to the LORD.

Lev 7:11-14 "And this is the law of the sacrifice of peace offerings that one may offer to the LORD.

(12) If he offers it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the thanksgiving sacrifice unleavened loaves mixed with oil, unleavened wafers smeared with oil, and loaves of fine flour well mixed with oil.

(13) With the sacrifice of his peace offerings for thanksgiving he shall bring his offering with loaves of leavened bread. (14) And from it he shall offer one loaf from each offering, as a gift to the LORD. It shall belong to the priest who throws the blood of the peace offerings.

Mat 16:6 Jesus said to them,
"Watch and beware of the leaven
of the Pharisees and Sadducees."

Mat 16:12 Then they understood
that he did not tell them to
beware of the leaven of bread,
but of the teaching of the
Pharisees and Sadducees.

1Co 5:6-8 Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump? (7) Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. (8) Let us therefore celebrate the festival, not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.



Num 9:13 But if anyone who is clean and is not on a journey fails to keep the Passover, **that person shall be cut off from his people because he did not bring the LORD's offering at its appointed time; that man shall bear his sin.**

1Co 11:27-30 Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty concerning the body and blood of the Lord. (28) Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. (29) For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself. (30) That is why many of you are weak and ill, and some have died.

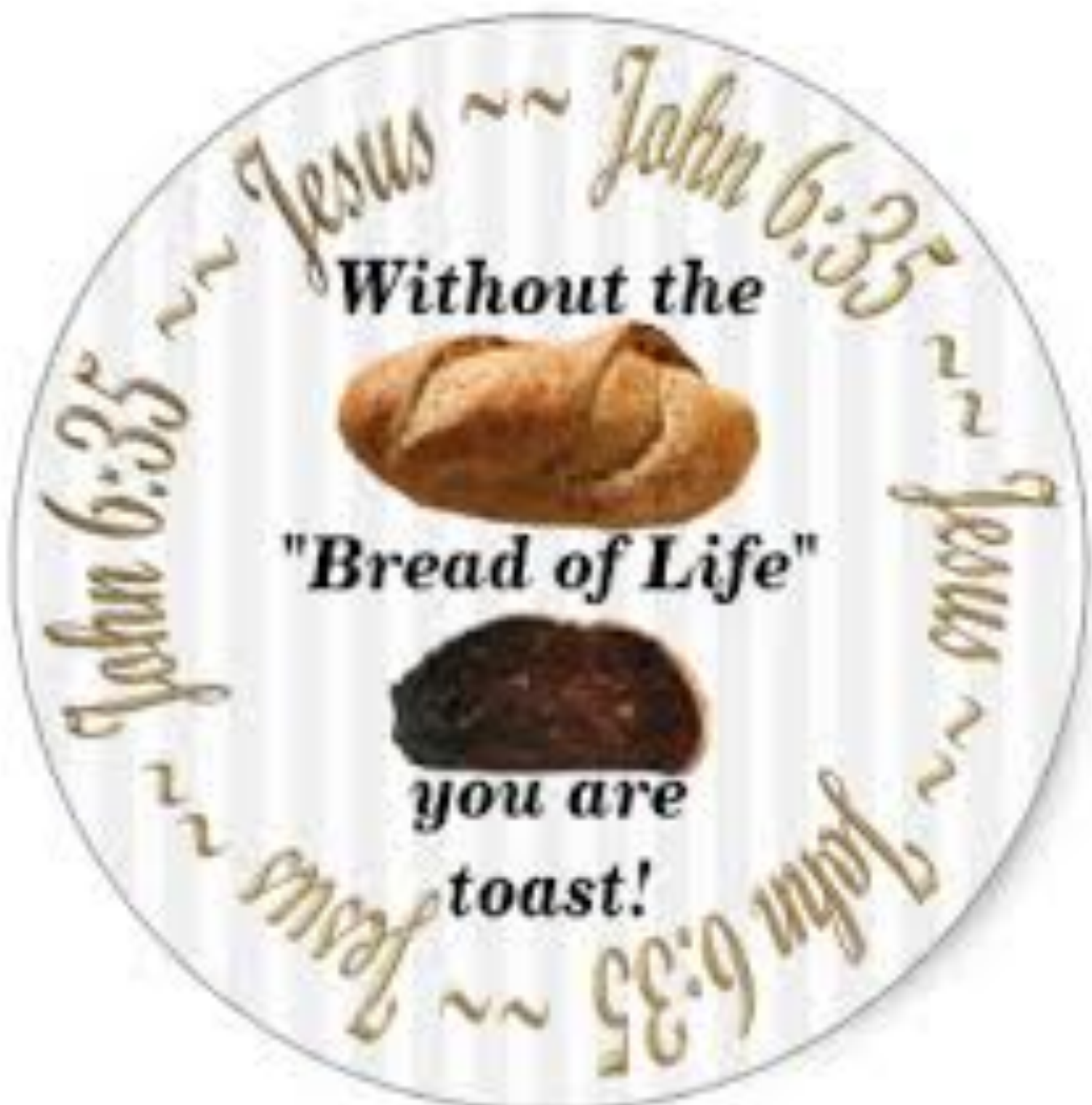
Act 2:27-32 For you will not abandon my soul to Hades, or let your Holy One see corruption. ...
"Brothers, I may say to you with confidence about the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. (30) Being therefore a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would set one of his descendants on his throne, (31) he foresaw and spoke about the resurrection of the Christ, that he was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh see corruption. (32) This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses.

Act 13:35-37 Therefore he says also in another psalm, "'You will not let your Holy One see corruption.' (36) For David, after he had served the purpose of God in his own generation, fell asleep and was laid with his fathers and saw corruption, (37) but he whom God raised up did not see corruption.

Deu 16:5-6 You may not offer the
